

Dear Mr. Bejgrowicz:

I am in receipt of your correspondence dated September 5, 2006. Please understand that I am happy to share information with you. However, perhaps you are not aware that we never stated it was for financial reasons alone that we are not considering the addition of soccer. I have included a letter that was sent explaining the position of the Administration and the Board. After reviewing the letter, if you still wish to have the requested information provided to you, please be aware of two things. (1.) Some of the information will take time for administrators and secretaries to accurately gather, and (2.) I consulted with the District Solicitor seeking his expertise in regard to your request. He is of the opinion that since the work will be gathered and assembled outside of the parameter of the regular workday, it will be necessary to charge the requesting organization for the time to gather this data and the Board Policy of 25 cents per page copy fee will be assessed.

In meeting with the Principal and the Athletic Director, we have determined that to answer questions 1-4, it will take approximately 60 minutes (1 hour.) Questions 5-8 will take considerably longer time. The Principal and the Athletic Director estimate that it will take approximately 10 hours to analyze, segregate, and report to you the information that you have requested. Please take this into consideration and let me know if you still wish that we proceed. If yes, I will need \$454.30 up front to begin the data gathering process. You will not have to pay the 25 cents per copy charge until we have finished and know the exact number of pages. I await your reply. Please be assured that we will expeditiously gather the requested information if that is your decision.
